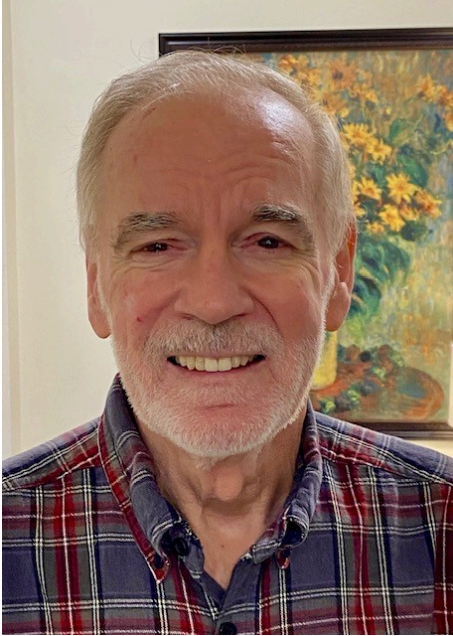

King was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 at the age of 35, making him the youngest person to receive the honor at that time. The national holiday became law in 1983 and is observed in all 50 states, often in conjunction with a statewide Civil Rights Day.
