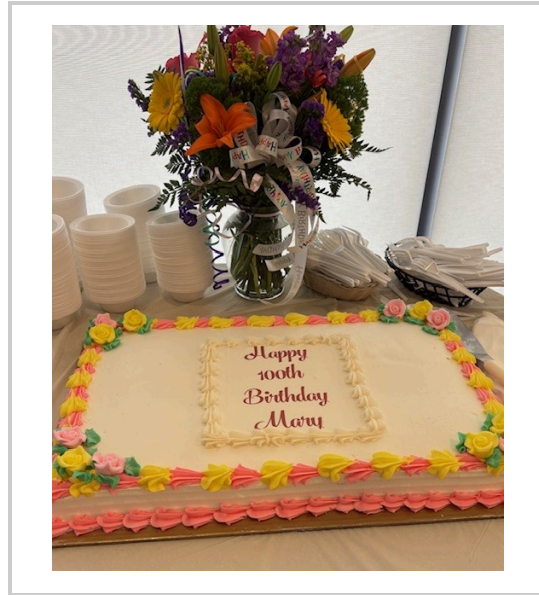
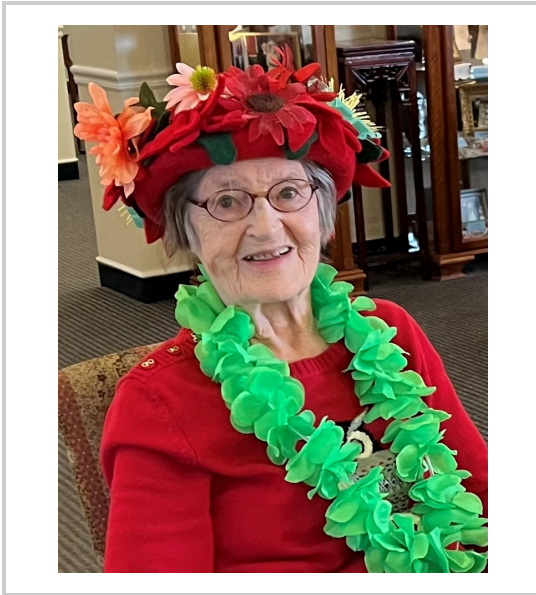


A Milestone Event: Mary Doyle Celebrates 100
