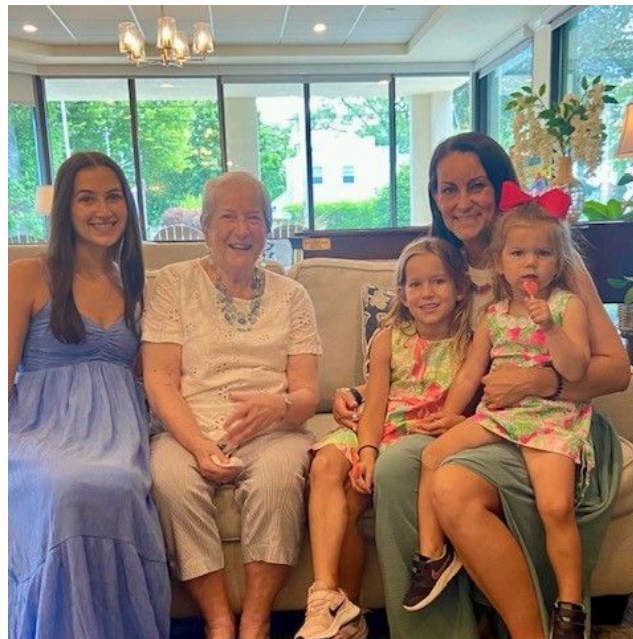


**Smiling faces all around!**

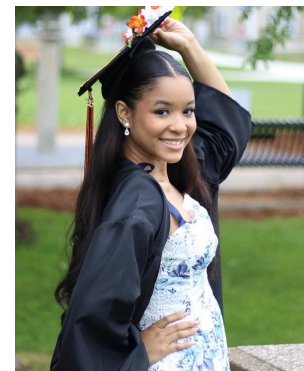
